Type 1 Diabetes (T1D) is an autoimmune disease in which a person's pancreas stops producing insulin—a hormone essential to turning food into energy. It strikes both children and adults and is unrelated to diet and lifestyle. With T1D there are no days off, and there is no cure—yet.

Taylor was diagnosed with type 1 diabetes (T1D) on September 1, 2015 at 11 years old. This day forever changed her life.... and mine. The next three days were so overwhelming! As we were leaving the hospital, absolute panic set in! Would I remember what to do? How are things going to change? I'll be the first to admit that it was not an easy adjustment, but Taylor never broke a stride! She walked back into school the next week, looked at me and said, "Mom, I'll be okay." She still tells me that when she goes for sleepovers with her friends, sporting events, and school functions. Over the past 2-1/2 years, there have times when I just wanted to sit down and cry, but Taylor has been so strong through it all and has never once questioned "Why me?" Her positive attitude is contagious and she wants to help others with T1D.

Taylor is now 14 years old and is on an insulin pump and CGM. She will begin running track in the spring and hasn't let T1D hold her back! She has her sights set on pediatric endocrinology! She is a very determined young lady and I know that God has a plan for her and that she will touch lives through this terrible disease.

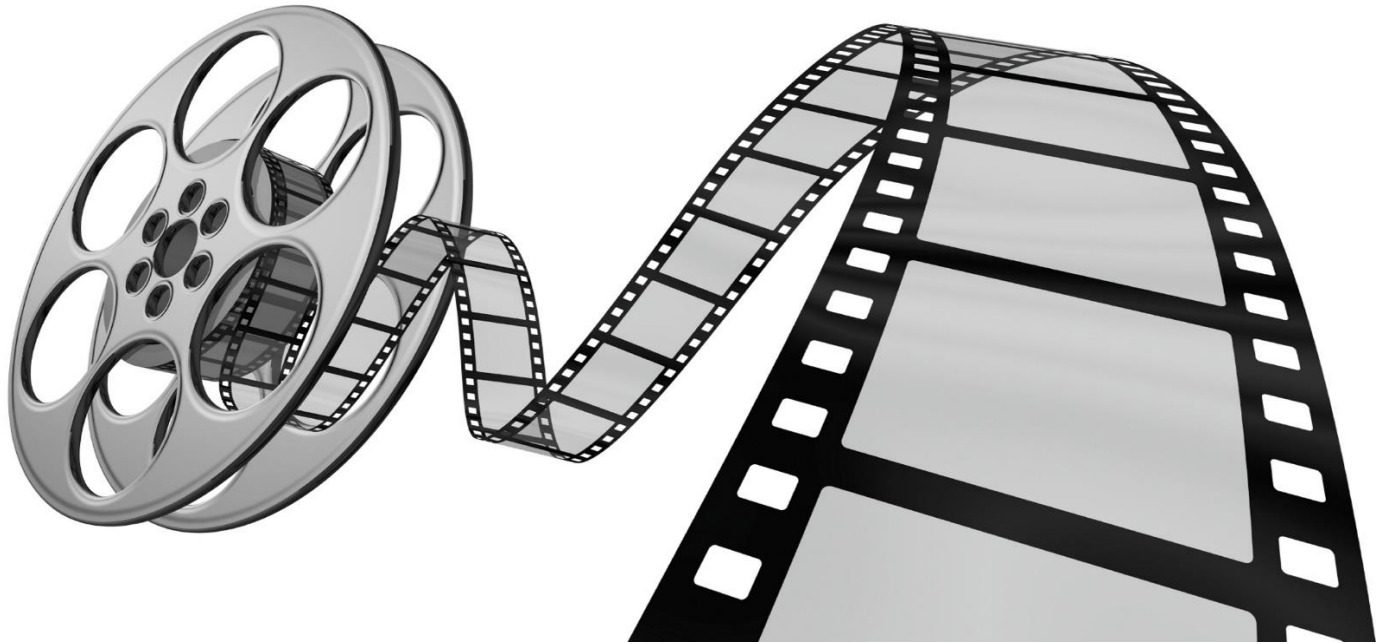
